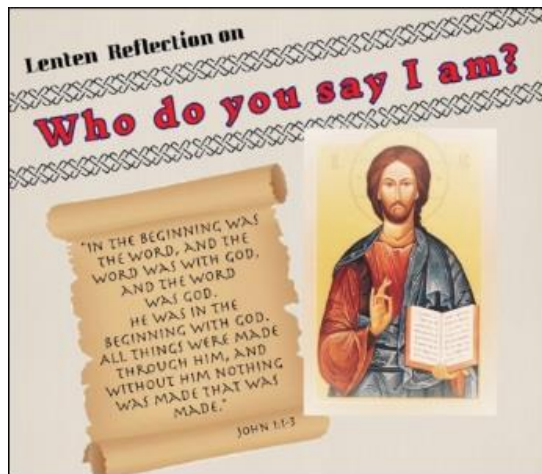

In October 2019 the Ukrainian Catholic Foundation called for applications for the Ukrainian Catholic Foundation Grant Fund Program. This Grant Fund was established when the Sheptytsky Institute building was sold, and the proceeds of sale were used to establish the Ukrainian Catholic Foundation Grant Fund Program.
