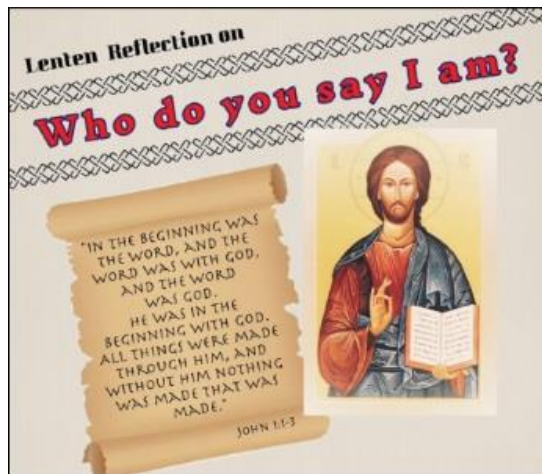

HIGHLIGHTS OF DORMITION PARISH ANNUAL MEETING

Thanks to our Knights of Columbus who hosted a breakfast before the meeting, and to those who parishioners who participated in our AGM last Sunday. It was a great meeting! In addition to reviewing the pastoral and financial reports of 2019, the following motions were accepted by the parish membership at our Annual Meeting on March 1st, 2020:

1. That Dormition Parish hire a part-time "Program Coordinator" to assist with parish pastoral programming and more fully engage our membership in the life of the parish;
2. That Dormition Parish establish a "Parish Finance Committee" to work in collaboration with our Parish Pastoral Council to oversee a long-term financial strategy for the parish, track Key Performance Indicators and coordinate planned giving opportunities for members;
3. That Dormition Parish continue to engage an architect to further develop the design and details of a parish building expansion, completing the appeal process with the City of Saskatoon (with a limit on spending up to \$5,000).
