Prayer, Fasting & Almsgiving: The Three Pillars of Lent

1. A SUGGESTION FOR PRAYER

Start & End Your Day During Lent with The Prayer of St. Ephrem

O Lord and Master of my life, Keep from me the spirit of indifference and discouragement, Lust of power and idle chatter. (*Prostration*)

Instead, grant to me Your servant,
The spirit of wholeness of being, humble-mindedness,
patience and love. (Prostration)

O Lord and King,

Grant me the grace to be aware of my sins,

And not to judge my neighbour,

For You are blessed, now and forever and ever. (Prostration)

2. FASTING? ... Try these Lenten Recipes!

Sauerkraut and Peas

3 cups sauerkraut

3/4 cups water

1 cup cooked dried peas

1 medium onion

3 tbsp. cooking oil

2 tbsp. flour

½ clove garlic, crushed (optional)

Salt and pepper to taste

Rinse sauerkraut in warm water; drain. Cover with water and cook for 20 minutes. Cook onion in oil until tender. Sprinkle flour over onions and brown lightly. Add gradually to cooked sauerkraut, stirring constantly, until thickened. Add garlic (if desired) and cooked peas. Simmer for 30 minutes until thickened.

Potato Pancakes

3 cups finely grated raw potatoes

1 onion, grated

1 tsp. salt

1 tsp. pepper

3 tbsp. flour

Mix thoroughly. Drop from spoon about the size of small pancakes into hot, well-oiled fry pan. Level with fork and fry until browned on both sides. Serve with apple sauce or crushed garlic.

Purchase food and place it in bins provided in your grocery store. Items most needed include: any non-perishable items for adults, children and babies.



Theodore Court Case Update: Theodore Supreme Court Leave NOT GRANTED!!!

On February 25, 2021, the Supreme Court of Canada dismissed Good Spirit (Public) School Division's application for leave to appeal the Theodore case to the Supreme Court of Canada. This means that the unanimous decision of the Saskatchewan Court of Appeal that overturned the April 2017 trial decision stands. Good Spirit has exhausted their legal options, and the decision of the Appeal Court remains the law in Saskatchewan—which can be considered a victory for both religious and parental rights and freedoms.
