Glory to Jesus Christ!

Today is the Third Sunday of Great Lent - the Sunday of the Veneration of the Holy Cross. In his book, Great Lent, Fr. Alexander Schmemman writes: "Lent is our self-crucifixion, our experience, limited as it is, of Christ's commandment heard in the Gospel lesson of that Sunday: "If any man would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me" (Mark 8:34). But we cannot take up our cross and follow Christ unless we have His Cross which He took up in order to save us. It is His Cross, not ours, that saves us. It is His Cross that gives not only meaning but also power to others."

2. FASTING? ... Try these Lenten Recipes!

- 1. Fast from anger and hatred. Give the people nearest and dearest to you an extra dose of love each day.
- 2. Fast from judging others. Remember what it might be like to walk in another's shoes.

- 4. **Fast from complaining.** Recall the gifts of grace you have received in your life and the moments of joy.
