INTERESTING . . . The Myrrh-bearing women were the first to arrive at the tomb of Christ. There were 8 women generally identified as Mary Magdalene; Mary, Joanna; Salome; Mary, wife of Cleopas (or Alphaeus); Susanna; Mary of Bethany; and Mary of Bethany; and Mary, the Theotokos who came in different groups. They came with funeral spices and ointments to prepare the body of Christ. The first five were wealthy so would have been able to buy the oils and ointments.

Imagine their surprise when they saw that the tomb was empty! Mary Magdalene recognized the voice of Christ who instructed them to bring the joyful news to the apostles.


