Conscience Rights – Bill C-268, introduced by MP Kelly Block, aims to amend the Criminal Code to make it an offence to intimidate a medical practitioner, nurse practitioner, pharmacist or other health care professional for the purpose of compelling them to take part, directly or indirectly, in the provision of medically-assisted suicide or euthanasia. It also makes it an offence to dismiss from employment or to refuse to employ a medical practitioner, nurse practitioner, pharmacist or other health care professional for the reason only that they refuse to take part, directly or indirectly, in medically-assisted suicide or euthanasia.
