In the Byzantine Tradition, the first Sunday after Pentecost is dedicated to the commemoration of all the saints. The Roman Catholic Church celebrates this feast on November 1st. It began to be celebrated in Antioch during the 4th Century. It was initially a feast of all the martyrs, then other saints were gradually added.
