All of you will have heard by now the awful news that the remains of 215 children were found on the site of the former Kamloops Indian Residential School in Kamloops, BC. What can we do in response to this news? Acknowledge the truth. Light a candle, say a prayer, or have a minute of silence in remembrance of the lives that were taken. Children did survive Indian Residential School – treat these survivors with respect and take the initiative to learn their story in ways that do not burden them but acknowledge their stories and see their resilience and strength. Educate yourself and become more aware of the impacts of the Residential School System by visiting the [Legacy of Hope Foundation](http://LegacyofHopeFoundation.ca). Today we celebrate the Holy Eucharist. This reminds us that when we receive the body and blood of Christ, we become Christ bearers and have the duty of conveying Christ to others at home and in the workplace, as love, mercy, forgiveness with humble and sacrificial service. The Holy Eucharist is the mystery of our Faith, the mystery of our Hope, and the mystery of our Charity.
