Although the Province of Saskatchewan is officially lifting restrictions for most public gatherings, be advised that COVID-19 protocols at Dormition Parish will remain in effect until further notice.

- Maximum capacity for in-person attendance at all liturgical services will remain at 40 people/Liturgy.
- Advanced [registration](#) is still required to attend Divine Liturgy on Sundays at 9:30AM or 11:30AM.
- Seating will ensure 2 metre distancing between individual households.
- Wearing masks will be required while inside the church.
- Holy Communion will be distributed using a different spoon for each Communicant.
- Livestreaming of the 9:30AM Sunday Divine Liturgy and some weekday liturgies can still be accessed via [YouTube](#) or [Facebook](#), but you are strongly encouraged to attend in-person.

On Sunday, August 15th, Dormition Parish will celebrate its annual **Feast Day** or Parish Praznyk. At the conclusion of the 9:30AM Divine Liturgy and Water Blessing that day, take out meals will be available for lunch, which you can either take home with you or can enjoy outside 'picnic-style' on the church lawn. 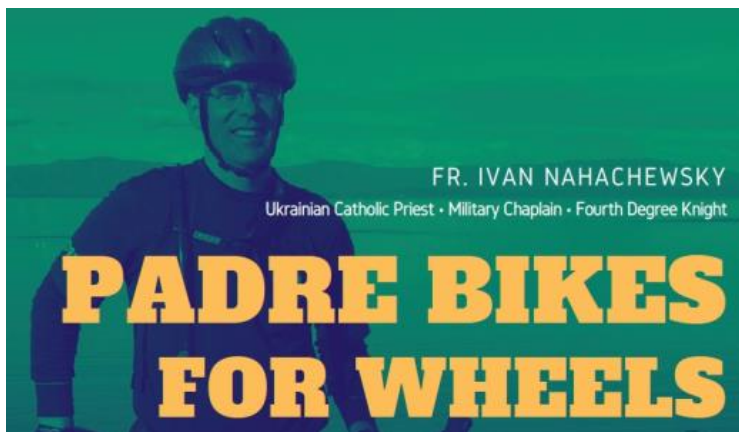

Reconciliation and healing – financial appeal announced by Saskatchewan bishops: In a joint letter released July 3, the five Catholic bishops of Saskatchewan wrote to faithful across the province about plans for a new fundraising appeal for residential school survivors, families and communities, saying: “We have heard the strong request, from Indigenous and non-Indigenous people in various quarters to initiate a new fundraising campaign to support survivors and engage more deeply in our own ongoing commitment and response to the Truth and Reconciliation process. Many members of our Catholic community have expressed their solidarity and support for the ongoing work of healing for survivors and their families, which could take the shape of supporting local projects of the National Indian Brotherhood and responding locally to TRC Calls to Action involving a financial commitment, as guided by Indigenous communities here in Saskatchewan.” Watch for more details about this initiative.
