Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Saskatchewan will be moving into Step 3 of the Re-Opening Roadmap on Sunday, July 11<sup>th</sup>. While this is very good news for all of us and means the lifting of emergency restrictions in the province, please be advised that COVID-19 protocols at Dormition Parish will remain in effect until the end of the summer. In other words,

- Maximum capacity for in-person attendance at all liturgical services will remain at 40 people/Liturgy.
- Advanced [registration](#) will be required to attend Divine Liturgy on Sundays at 9:30AM or 11:30AM.
- Seating will ensure 2 metre distancing between individual households.
- Wearing masks will be required while inside the church.
- Holy Communion will be distributed using a different spoon for each Communicant.
- Livestreaming of the 9:30AM Sunday Divine Liturgy and some weekday liturgies can still be accessed via [YouTube](#) or [Facebook](#), but you are strongly encouraged to attend in-person.

Many of us have been wondering about how to focus our concern and respond to the ongoing challenges caused by residential schools on our Indigenous brothers and sisters. The Bishops of Saskatchewan have written a [letter](#) outlining movement in that direction.

Further, in response to fires and property damage incurred by many Catholic churches in Canada in recent weeks, Bishop David Motiuk from the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of Edmonton has written the following [reflection](#). I encourage you to read it and prayerfully reflect on how we can all move forward towards reconciliation and healing.


