A reminder that beginning this Sunday, August 8th...

- It is no longer necessary to register to attend Liturgy in-person.
- Please sanitize your hands when entering and exiting the church.
- Please wear a mask if it makes you feel safer and/or more comfortable, but they are not compulsory.
- Pews will be returned to the 'normal' configuration.
- The Divine Liturgy and hymn books will be available at each pew.
- Holy Communion will continue to be distributed under both species (consecrated bread and wine) using individual spoons.
- As always: Anyone with COVID symptoms should remain at home and schedule a test. Isolate from others until test results are back.

Next Sunday, August 15th, Dormition Parish will celebrate its annual **Feast Day** or Parish Praznyk. Reconciliation and healing – financial appeal announced by Saskatchewan bishops: In a joint letter released July 3, the five Catholic bishops of Saskatchewan wrote to faithful across the province about plans for a new fundraising appeal for residential school survivors, families and communities, saying: “We have heard the strong request, from Indigenous and non-Indigenous people in various quarters to initiate a new fundraising campaign to support survivors and engage more deeply in our own ongoing commitment and response to the Truth and Reconciliation process. Many members of our Catholic community have expressed their solidarity and support for the ongoing work of healing for survivors and their families, which could take the shape of supporting local projects of the National Indian Brotherhood and responding locally to TRC Calls to Action involving a financial commitment, as guided by Indigenous communities here in Saskatchewan.”
