After this past week's meeting of Pope Francis and representatives of Indigenous, Metis and Inuit communities, the Holy Father issued an apology at the Vatican for the Catholic Church's role in what is known as the Indian Residential School System. Many people – Indigenous and non-Indigenous – remarked that the Holy Father's words and sentiments are heartfelt and provide much food for thought and reflection as we continue the long journey of careful and respectful hearing of stories from Indigenous peoples that marks the path towards healing. "From Mourning to Dawn" is open to participants who have been widows/widowers between two months and two years. Cost is \$35. Summary and Accountability:
