Brothers and sisters,

This past Thursday, we received the news that the Holy Father, Pope Francis, appointed **His Excellency Bryan J. Bayda, CSsR** as Bishop of the Ukrainian Catholic Eparchy of Toronto and Eastern Canada. Bishop Bryan was appointed Bishop of Saskatoon in 2008 and had also been serving as Apostolic Administrator of the Eparchy of Toronto since November 2019, following the resignation of Bishop-emeritus Stephen Chmilar.

Over the next few months Bishop Bryan will be bidding his beloved Eparchy of Saskatoon farewell and preparing to take permanent residence in an Eparchy he has already visited extensively over the past two and a half years and come to love. The territory of the Eparchy of Toronto and Eastern Canada spans from Kenora, Ontario to Sydney, Nova Scotia. Details regarding Bishop Bryan's episcopal installation will be made public as soon as they are finalized.

In conjunction with Bishop Bryan's appointment to Toronto, **His Grace, Metropolitan Lawrence Huculak, OSBM**, Archbishop of Winnipeg, has been appointed Apostolic Administrator of the Eparchy of Saskatoon.

We pray for Bishop Bryan and this new chapter in his Ministry, and we welcome Metropolitan Lawrence as our new Apostolic Administrator.
