St. Philip Neri Refugee Committee Annual Plant Sale: Tomato, pepper and herb plants must be preordered by May 17 for pick up May 19 or May 21 at St. Philip Neri Parish, Taylor St.W. and Munroe Ave. S, Saskatoon. Plants will be in 5" pots and are \$6 per plant or 4 for \$20. Varieties include **tomatoes**: Lemon Boy (yellow slicer, low acid), Defiant (red slicer, late blight resistant), Primo Red (red slicer, good flavor), Supremo (Roma type for sauces and canning), Vilma (small plants for pots with small tomatoes), SuperSweet 100 (cherry size fruit, larger plants, sweet), Tumbling Tom Red (plants are recommended for hanging baskets with cherry size red fruit) / **peppers**: El Jefe (jalapeno, medium hot), Red Knight (sweet bell pepper), Long Red Cayenne (long thin pepper, hot) / **herbs**: basil, oregano, lavender, and thyme. (A limited number of Nanking Cherry shrubs will also be available for \$10 each).
